The cafe has been closed the past three days while equipment and stock has been moved to the former Dunlap Hardware building across the street.

The Bissens have done much work in remodeling and renovating the building. A kitchen area has been built in the back half of the room, tile flooring has been laid, wall paneling placed and rest rooms installed. A private club and party rooms also being provided at the rear of the building.

Booths and equipment used in the former location have been moved across the street. The dining area will be much larger and more tables are being installed.
